Remote Learning Information and Recommendations



Remote Learning Information

- Students will be provided with a Chromebook device and access to the Seesaw app for remote learning.
- Students will use Seesaw as the learning management system.
- Students will be provided with a consistent schedule that includes online lessons/assessments and self-paced independent learning activities through Seesaw.
- The classroom teacher will communicate the daily schedule via Seesaw.
- Students are expected to participate in daily live lessons (Zoom video-conferencing) for whole groups and small groups to include Reading/Language Arts and Math. *The live lessons will be recorded and made available to students if they are unable to attend at the scheduled time.*
- Students are expected to participate in Unified Arts lessons (Physical Education/Health, Music, Art, and Library/Media) as they have been in school. Students must submit assignments or evidence of participation (video, audio, log, picture, etc.) in the UA sessions.
- Students will be provided with program materials (textbooks, workbooks, etc.) and Chromebook devices that they would receive for in-person learning. Parents will be notified of when these items will be sent home.
- Intervention services will continue to be provided for eligible students.

Video-conferencing (Zoom) Recommendations

- Students should use their first name and last initial when logging in. Students may need adult assistance with logging in to their devices and different accounts.
- Students should have their cameras on during Zoom lessons.
- A student's entire face should be visible.
- Students should be ready to sign on to Zoom at the start of each class and wait in the waiting room until admitted.
- Students should log into the Zoom meeting from a distraction-free, quiet environment.
- Headphones/earbuds with microphones are recommended to limit background noise and distractions. If your child is in a location where there are other children or other people, have them sit with their backs towards a wall for privacy reasons. There are other students and families zooming into class as well.
- While it may be fun, students' pets are not allowed to be held during the lesson.
- It's recommended that students sit at a desk or table, not in bed or on the couch.
- Students are expected to attend scheduled lessons unless otherwise directed by the teachers or if it is an emergency. If there are continued issues, the classroom teachers will reach out to parents to discuss the matter and to create some solutions.
- Students should be in a room that is lighted.
- Students should come prepared to class as they would in person.
- Students are required to dress as they would in person. Students must be fully clothed. Pajamas, bathing suits, and costumes are not permitted.
- Students must submit school work/assignments by 8:00 pm on the day that it is due. Students may submit their completed work by 8:00 am on the following day if there are extenuating circumstances. The priority is to complete and submit the assignments during the regular school day.
- Students must follow school rules and exhibit responsible, safe, and kind behavior while class is in session.
- If students are unable to follow the expectations, students will be placed in the Zoom waiting room until the teacher can discuss the concerns with them individually.
